

NATIONAL ELIGIBILITY CUM ENTRANCE TEST (NEET) PG (2020)

National Eligibility Cum Entrance Examination for Post Graduation or NEET PG 2020 is a compulsory entrance examination that the students need to attempt to study MD/MS and PG Diploma Courses in any college that is recognised by the Medical Council of India (MCI). The registration for NEET PG 2020 examination is already over. The examination will be conducted on January 5, 2020, by the National Board of Examination (NBE).

The important dates for NEET PG 2020 examination are as follows:

NEET PG 2020 examination will be valid for the following institutes:

1. All India 50% quota seats (all States & UT 's)
2. State quota seats. (including the UT 's)
3. All Private Medical Colleges, Institutions & Universities/Deemed Universities all across the country
4. Armed Forces Medical Services Institutions.
5. DNB Post MBBS Courses.

Following institutions will not accept NEET PG 2020 ranks:

1. AIIMS, New Delhi and other AIIMS
2. PGIMER, Chandigarh
3. JIPMER, Puducherry

4. NIMHANS, Bengaluru
5. Sree Chitra Tirunal Institute for Medical Sciences and Technology, Trivandrum

Eligibility Criteria

The candidates need to make sure that they pass the eligibility criteria for NEET PG 2020 examination in order to attempt the examination. The eligibility criteria are as follows:

- **Education:** The candidate needs to have MBBS degree or Provisional MBBS Pass Certificate that is required by the Medical Council of India.
- **Registration Certificate:** The candidate needs to have a permanent or provisional registration certificate of MBBS qualification which they have received after completing their MBBS from the Medical Council of India.
- **Internship:** All the candidates need to complete their one-year internship on or before March 31, 2020.

For Foreign Medical Graduates:

They need to possess a valid medical certificate that is recognised by the Medical Council of India. The candidate needs to qualify for the Foreign Medical Graduate Examination (FMGE) that is conducted by the National Board of Examination. The internship should be completed on or before March 31, 2020. They need to register themselves with the Medical Council of India /State Medical Council.

For Foreign Nationals:

They need to own a legitimate medical certificate that is approved by the Medical Council of India. The candidate needs to qualify for the Foreign Medical Graduate Examination (FMGE) that is conducted by the National Board of Examination. The internship should be completed on or before March 31, 2020. They can apply for the examination without any temporary registration by the Medical Council of India but should have it at the time of the admission.

Application fees for NEET PG 2020

The students need to application fee online at the time registration. The application fee are as follows:

Important Documents

The candidates should carry the following documents at the time of examination:

- Admit Card
- Permanent / Provisional SMC/MCI registration*
- Photo ID Proof (valid/original)
- Passport for Foreign National (original and valid)

The students need to carry the following documents at the time of counselling:

- NEET PG 2020 Examination Results
- Marksheet of MBBS
- NEET PG 2020 Admit Card
- Degree Certificate or Provisional Certificate for MBBS
- Internship completion certificate
- Permanent or provisional registration certificate issued by the Medical Council of India (MCI) or State Medical Council (SMC)
- Date of birth proof (High school/higher secondary certificate)
- ID proof (PAN card, driving license, voter ID, passport and Aadhaar card)
- Certificate for Category issued by competent authority
- PwD Certificate issued by the medical board
