

# NATIONAL ELIGIBILITY CUM ENTRANCE TEST (NEET) UG (2020)

National Eligibility-cum-Entrance Test 2020 is a single-window entrance examination that will be conducted by the National Testing Agency (NTA) for students to take admission to MBBS, BDS, BAMS, BUMS, and BHMS courses in any of the Indian colleges. As per the latest notification by the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare (MHFW), the institutes of national importance (AIIMS and JIPMER MBBS exam) will not conduct any entrance examination for their UG courses.

## Eligibility Criteria

The students need to check the eligibility criteria before applying for the examination. The general eligibility criteria are as follows:

- **Education:** The students need to complete their 10+2 Higher/Senior Secondary Examination with the required pass percentage marks at the time of the first round of counselling. The last two years of study comprises of Physics, Chemistry, Biology/Bio-technology (which shall include practical tests in these subjects) and Mathematics or any other elective subject with English.
- **Age:** The candidates who are applying for the examination need to be 17 years of age at the time of the admission. They can also complete the age on or before December 31 of the year of his/her admission to the 1st year MBBS/BDS Course.
- **Percentage:** The students must get the minimum marks of 50% for general category students, 45% marks for students from PwD Category, and 40% marks for the students from the SC/ST Category.

## Application Fee

The candidates need to pay the application fee after submitting their application form.

## Important Documents

**For examination day, the students need to carry the following documents:**

- Print copy of Admit Card downloaded from NTA's website

- One passport size photograph which is same as what was uploaded at the time of the application fees
- One photo id (Government verified) such as Driving License/Voter ID/Passport/Aadhaar Card (with photograph) /Ration Card/any other
- PwD certificate (if needed) that is issued by a competent authority.

**The students need to have the following documents during the time of the counselling:**

- Print copy of Admit Card downloaded from NTA's website
- Rank/Result Letter
- Class 10 Marksheet and Certificate
- Class 12 Marksheet and Certificate
- Passport size photographs
- ID Proof
- Category Certificate (if required)
